Try This Recipe

Try this for a quick lunch or a side at dinner. My sister says it goes great with pork chops!.

My mother was a girl scout leader and whenever they camped out, one of the favorites was 'Bags of Gold'. Cooks best in a cast iron skillet!

2 cans of Campbell's Tomato Soup 2 cans of water

Mix and heat on stove. Bring to boil. Turn down to a simmer.

Follow recipe on Bisquick box for biscuits (one batch) Take Velveeta cheese, cut it in six (6) approxi-mately ¾ inch cubes. Divide biscuit mix into six dough balls. Use thumb to make indentation in biscuit, place cheese cube and wrapped cheese inside dough, sealing all edges securely. (If you don't, cheese will run out.). When all are finished, place dough balls in hot simmering soup with the sealed edges facing upward. Cover and simmer 20 minutes. Tooth pick should come out dry. Ladle soup over top of each biscuit and serve. Kids love it!!!! So does my finicky brother-in-law.
